
This agreement commences as of the date of its signing.

## MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The parties also mutually agree to exchange information related to their respective activities and report the information to the members through their bulletins.


The sister clubs will work together to promote mutual activities in accordance with the Rotary Future Vision Plan (Seven causes), especially in Arts, Music,
